Currently the supervision of Nuclear Medicine practitioners is undertaken through the ANZSNM. This system works well and provides consistency of practice and supervision. I would suggest that once National registration is underway a similar system should be established.

This ensures that Nuclear Medicine technologists have practical experience as well as academic experience. The PDY technologist has to be evaluated 4 times per year. This evaluation concerns their entire work experience.

The introduction of graduate entry courses, in my opinion, should still require the same practical supervised period of work.

I agree with the restrictions placed on On call work and the level of experience of the supervisors. Thanks for giving us this opportunity to comment,
