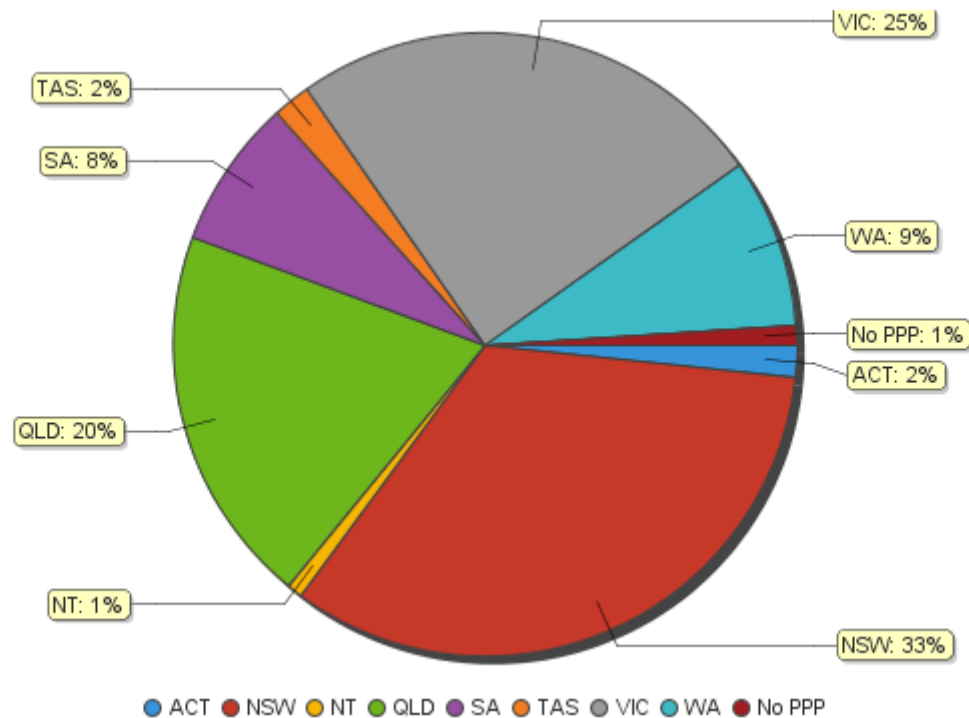

Medical Radiation practitioners – percentage by principal place of practice



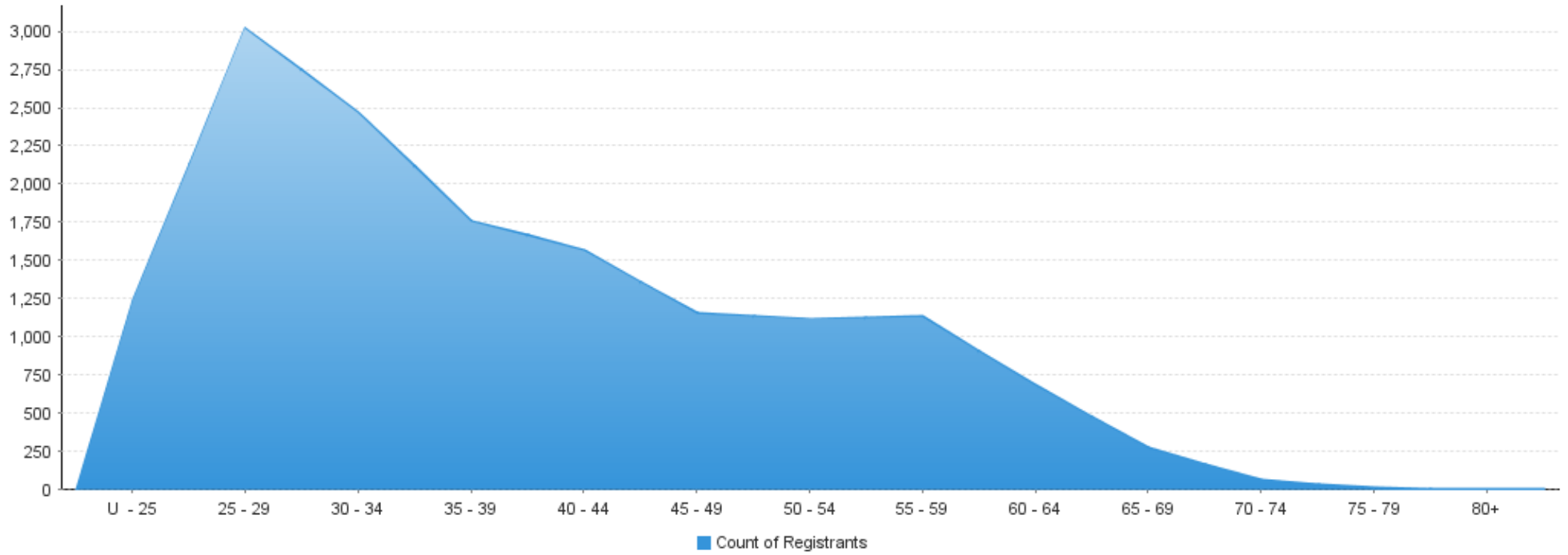
